Membership and Finance Report-Kelly

We do not know how much we have made on wood currently or if we owe anything Denise has that money and information at the office. Washer and dryer and fire wood was collected last when we did the festival in September. Detergent is still at the office. We discussed the vending machine for the washing location. Old Business:

Topographic Map – James Whitacre

James and Aaron printed off a few copies for reviews. Last spring Ken approached IUP to produce a map. James was given the project with a few others. They took data and produced the lake map to include a trail map. We looked at the two different maps. We reviewed the time line James set and will go with that time line: Feb 28th we want to go to print. March 16 maps to be available. Smaller copies are meant for those who will be selling advertizing to show an example of what the lake looks like. There are some changes that will need to be done. Work on the legend and colors, etc. - 24x36 is the size that it will be.

Need to: 1) Visit Gazette printers 2) Need a meeting date to decide final changes, what will be on legends, People involved will meet after our meeting to set dates and work on details. 3) We decided on what we need to charge for advertizing space - $6-2\frac{1}{2}x2\frac{1}{2}$ small for \$250 non negotiable; 1-5.1x2.5 large for \$450; 1-5.12x3 x-large for \$500 premium spot – both large and x-large are negotiable down \$50, We will get 1000 copies for about 1,500.00. We could sell the ads by saying the cost per map is \$1,000 for 250 and that is 25 cents a map. We want to cover the map cost and anything over is profit for the FOYC. We could sell the map for \$20.00. Could maybe sell whole sale for ? # of maps for a little less.
