Food summary:

May not want to use the concession stand again – maybe better under a tent where people could see it.

Date for next year – 2012 -Clymer Days etc, open artists tour – all on the weekend of the 22nd. We should have the fest the weekend of Sept 29th. Ken S. will get it on the Tablespoon calendar.

Suggestions:

Old Business:

Individuals don't hold it. It could be DCNR, IUP, FOYC??? James said you can register for an ISPN on the web site for a few hundred dollars. If we are not thinking of selling it like that we do not have to get it. It does make it somewhat official. We can purchase the ISPN later on. You would have to do it again for future versions. Vicki noted that James should keep track of his volunteer hours.

We need a target dates to complete this project.

- End of Feb to go to press.
- Final review by beginning of Feb.
- Printed by March.
- Sponsors lined up by January 31st. We do have a model we can show sponsors. Name will be on till next printing.
- We will print about 1000 maps.
- Ben will create a marking letter, x number of spots, etc
- James will get 5 or 6 print outs to show people. There were 6-8 ad slots. Min. amount is based on the size of the block.
- James wants to make some changes on the trail map. He needs to get with Kelly and AJ to finalize a few things.
- YC camp ground, boat dealers, TJ at commonplace, B&B, Coy's, Riddles bait shops, Allegheny bass are all possibilities for sponsors. Ken and Ben will meet and go to contact sponsors together.
- James will spell out the time line in a letter for us.

Passports – We can get them at cost from State FOP – problem was how to get it stamped? Ken B said the state group came up with a state wide logo they had them printed and are on stickers – they are kept outside the office that people can take it and put it on their passport. Denise ordered the labels today. Ken asked if we can get 10 passports to keep at the office. Everyone agreed. They cost 6 or 7 dollars we can sell them for 10.00.

Board members:

We need a process as to official board members vs. members. Why did so many people drop out? Maybe the kickoff party in the spring might help create a buzz to recreate the interest. We need a calendar to re-up as a board member. We need to look at how the board works and how we need to add members. We need to send a note to Richard to ask if he is going to still be involved. Are the board members on the web site? Should they be? Maybe after we organize it better.

Ken B. announced Kennywood is doing their first ever lights, winter activities.
